Program Overview

Headquarters, U.S. Army Corps of Engineers (HQ USACE) created the Standards and Criteria Program (SCP) to maintain and develop criteria used to support tri-service Military Construction. The SCP maintains the existing inventory of Corps criteria documents (guide specifications, technical manuals, standard designs, etc.) and develops new criteria documents in technical areas where the need is identified. The U.S. Army Engineering and Support Center, Huntsville, is the program-executing agent for HQ USACE's SCP annual program and manages funding and document execution to include the following:

- Standards and Criteria Program Management
- UFC/UFGS Document Management
- Maintenance of the Unified Master Reference List (UMRL)
- Architect-Engineer Contracting Support for SCP Projects
- Technical Writing support
- SpecsIntact Program Management
