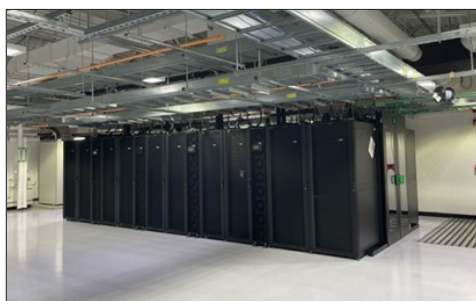
Through the Design-Build construction approach, the FRR team ensures timely and effective execution of high-priority projects across all 50 states and U.S. territories.

The current FRR Multiple Award Task Order Contract is a Design-Build vehicle that enables rapid response with unlimited value contracts for:

- Facility repair and renovation
- Conversion, alteration, and minor MILCON construction
- Subsystem equipment procurement and installation
- Facility commissioning and re-commissioning with construction
- Utility repair, installation, replacement
