In addition to meeting the basic requirement above, to qualify for this position you must also meet the qualification requirements listed below:

Selective Placement Factor: This position requires the incumbent to be registered as a Professional Engineer (PE) or Registered Architect (RA) through national or state level certification.

Specialized Experience for GS-13: One year of specialized experience which includes: successful performance as an engineer or architect providing advice regarding all matters associated with AE contract acquisition/execution and facility design. The ideal candidate will also have served as a contracting officer's representative (COR) on AE task orders and understand AE project lifecycle, to include:

- Statement of Work (SOW) Development.
- Solicitation process.
- Source Selection Evaluation Board (SSEB).
- Post-award contract administration.
- Design/submittal review.
- Knowledge of and administration of quality assurance and safety within a project/program.
- Familiarity with project schedules.
- Understanding of the contractor quality control and government quality assurance process.
- Contracting Performance Assessment Reporting System (CPARS)/ Closeout process.

This definition of specialized experience is typical of work performed at the next lower grade/level position in the federal service (GS-12).

<u>Responsibilities/Duties:</u> Serves as technical manager for planning, coordinating, and resolving major or unusual multi-discipline engineering problems associated with the design and construction of major military facilities. Other duties include:

Providing subject matter expert level support to new/pre-award acquisitions as well as post award
 Project and Technical Management to existing A-E Indefinite Delivery Contracts.

- Serving as the Contracting Officer's Representative, developing the scopes of work, independent government estimates, negotiating task orders and managing the overall execution of AE services contracts.
- Working with project managers and project engineers to resolve technical issues and ensuring all necessary engineering disciplines are involved in developing technically sound recommendations which may impact the design configuration and construction.
- Leading and coordinating the review of engineering studies, plans, specifications, and analyses of
 designs submitted by divisions, districts, and/or Architect Engineer (AE) contractors for accuracy,
 technical competency, and conformance to approved criteria.

Conditions of Employment:

- 1) Must meet suitability for Federal employment.
- 2) Will be required to provide proof of U.S. Citizenship.
- 3) Male applicants born after December 31, 1959 must complete a Pre-employment Certification Statement for Selective Service Registration.
- 4) May be required to serve a 2- year probationary period.
- 5) This is a Career Program (CP) 18 position.
- 6) Reasonable accommodation is available to qualified employees with disabilities.
- 7) Incumbent must be able to obtain and maintain a Secret clearance is required.
- 8) You will be required to file an OGE Form 450, Financial Disclosure report upon entering on duty and annually thereafter.
